THE ASK | PARTNER REQUIREMENTS

HOST ORGANIZATIONS WILL:

- Represent the company's work
- Have 30+ employees
- Have 3-6 volunteers from the company staff to guide the site visit
- Work with Women.NYC to finalize site visit details
- Have facilities that can host a minimum of 5 people
- Ideally, host will have 2-3 employees volunteer as advisors for 2-3 Digital Office Hours.

Participants must submit application & attend virtual onboarding session.
